

Admission Scoring Rubric: Medical Radiography

Applicants must meet all criteria to be eligible to apply for the Medical Radiography Program. Please see the admission checklist on the Medical Radiography Program Webpage.

In the case of a tied total score, the HESI A2 cumulative score will be used as the deciding factor. If still tied, the GPA for Pre-Requisite courses will be the deciding factor.

HESI Exam <i>Maximum 24 points .</i> 70 -74% = 1 point; 75 -79% = 2 points; 80-84% = 3 points; 85-89% =4 points; 90-94% = 5 points; 95-100% = 6 points Must have been taken <u>within 2 years</u> of application deadline to apply. Minimum score of 60 required in Vocabulary & General Knowledge, Science, Math. Minimum cumulative score of 70 required to apply. RDMS registered sonographer who graduated from a CAAHEP accredited AAS or BS Medical Imaging Program. (15 points) <i>Maximum 15 points.</i>	
Earned a Masters degree in any field from an accredited college or university. (4 points) <i>Maximum 4 points.</i>	
Earned a Bachelors degree in any field from an accredited college or university. (4 points) <i>Maximum 4 points.</i>	
Earned an Associates of Applied Science Degree in a direct patient care health science program from an accredited college or university. Direct patient care is defined as performing patient care tasks in clinical/practicum courses. (4 points) <i>Maximum 4 points.</i>	
Earned an Associates degree in any field from an accredited college or university. (2 points) <i>Maximum 2 points.</i>	
Completed a healthcare technical certificate program from an accredited college or university in a direct patient care field to include clinical/practicum course(s) of more than 100 hours. Direct patient care is defined as performing patient care tasks in clinical/practicum courses. Must submit transcript showing all courses including clinical/practicums. (2 points) <i>Maximum 2 points .</i>	
Completed a healthcare continuing education or professional development program in a direct patient care field with 0 to 100 clinical/practicum course hours. Must submit transcript or certificate of course/program completion. (1 point) <i>Maximum 1 point.</i>	

Deductions	Number of Courses or Programs	Points Deducted
3 points will be deducted for each prerequisite course attempt with a D, F, or FX within 5 years of program start date. Multiple attempts of same course will be counted individually. <i>No maximum point deduction.</i>		
10 points will be deducted if currently enrolled in a health science program with courses in progress and will not complete the program prior to radiography program start date. <i>Maximum 10 point deduction.</i>		
5 points will be deducted if within the past 5 years , applicant was enrolled in a health science program and did not complete. <i>-5 points for each occurrence. No maximum point deduction.</i>		
3 points will be deducted if applicant was enrolled in a health science program more than 5 years ago and did not complete. <i>-3 points for each occurrence. No maximum point deduction.</i>
